

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR FIRST PUBLIC HEARING

On or about July 10th, 2026, the Town of Kirklin intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Planning program. This program is funded by Title I of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development planning project that will include the following activities at a minimum: Single Utility Infrastructure Study, to assess the Town of Kirklin's Stormwater needs, including (but not limited to) evaluation of existing facilities, evaluation of acquisition issues, identification of program/service needs, cost analysis, and implementation and maintenance recommendations pursuant.

The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$27,000. The proportion of low-moderate income individuals served in the Town of Kirklin, based on the most recently completed income survey, is 53.85%. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-moderate income persons is \$14,539.50. The Applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$5,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following source: the local Storm Water Utility Operating line item.

A public hearing will be held on June 30th, 2026, at 7:00 p.m., at 113 N Main St, Kirklin, IN 46050, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally-funded CDBG project.
